A competitive, competent pedagogue who meets the requirements of today's time, knows his specialty perfectly, can introduce innovations, works tirelessly on himself, at the same time, can widely use information and communication technologies, knows foreign languages and can regularly apply them to the teaching process. Today, the main offer in the language market is formed according to the demand of the consumer. According to S.G. Ter-Minasova, a senior specialist in linguistics and foreign language teaching methods, "Today, language teaching has become more functional, and as a result of the strengthening of integration processes, the study of foreign languages, especially English, has become more relevant. But modern linguists are not interested in the history of language or its theory. English language has become necessary for them to meet their life needs. Currently, several methods are offered to students learning English. One of them is the fundamental method. It requires at least 2-3 years of study and deep study of grammar. This method is mainly used in the training of professional translators, and at the end of their studies, students will be able to look at the world through the eyes of a native speaker. Based on it, language is studied as a real and complete means of communication. Currently, the fundamental method has not changed its purpose, but many other methods have entered the field of competition with the fundamental method. One of them is the linguistic and sociocultural method. This method requires learning the language in a social and cultural environment. Its supporters condemn the fact that students are made to study "dead" lexical-grammatical forms. According to them, "a person is a product of culture." So the language too. In most cases, not learning the language in accordance with social life causes many mistakes. For example, a student of English might use the grammatically correct phrase "The Queen and Her relatives", but a British citizen would have difficulty understanding that "The Royal Family" is meant. For those who don't know the language well, "Dont you want to go?" and "Would you like to go?" The difference between the expressions is not that big, but to a British person they are different. In most cases, at conferences, "What other issues are you interested in?" "What problems are you interested in?" they translate as But it is worth noting that in English the word "problems" has a negative character, and such a sentence can be translated as "What issues are you interested in?" it is better to translate it as.

The experiment may be new to one teacher, but not new to another. In addition, the level of innovation of the same method may be different for future pedagogues. Taking this into account, both future pedagogues and teachers working in the educational system should approach innovative creative activities based on their needs. According to the level of innovation, innovative methods that help to develop the creative functions of future pedagogues are manifested in several forms: absolute level; local-absolute degree; conditional degree; subjective level. The mass application of innovative pedagogical innovations is interpreted as a criterion for their evaluation.



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This is mainly related to the technical support of the educational process and the uniqueness of the teacher's activity. The creative application of pedagogical innovations in mass pedagogical experiments is manifested at the initial stage of the work of individual teachers. These innovations will be available for public use after being pilot-tested and objectively evaluated.

Description of different methods of teaching English. It is the most relevant and intensive method of language learning in the modern and rapidly changing world. Today, the consumer can choose training for any taste - English for lawyers, English for economists, business English, etc. With this approach, listeners are given a lot of formulaic phrases and clichés. Linguistic-social-cultural method of language learning. This method is a systematic approach aimed at studying the cultural and social environment without the goal of "dry" acquisition of lexical features and grammatical constructions. Linguisticsocial-cultural method raises the veil of stylistic coloring and vitality of language. Two verbs, to do and do, are good examples. Their main difference is that the verb make means a creative approach to business, thoughtful actions. Based on the diagnosis of pedagogical innovations, it is recommended to carry out practical work aimed at learning in several stages. At the initial stage, questionnaire requests from future teachers, examination of answers to questionnaire questions, organization of individual interviews and confirmation of information in answers to questionnaire questions, analysis of information obtained based on the results of diagnosis. At this stage, based on the results of the first stage, activities aimed at improving the professional and pedagogical qualifications of the future teacher will be planned and the ways of their implementation will be shown.
